Elkhart electrically controlled aerial monitor  
Task Force Tip 1250 GPM electrically controlled monitor nozzle  
Atkinson aerial intercom system with controls at the pump panel and turntable  
4 – Collins lights on the aerial ladder  
Axe and pike pole mounting brackets on the outer fly section of the aerial ladder

Upper compartment are approx. 12" deep
